

Winter Sing 2014

Prelude Policy

As in years past, the Winter Sing prelude is an opportunity for students to perform on an instrument in front of their family members and peers.

Students in grades 3 and 4 who are *currently taking lessons* on an instrument are invited to audition to play at their Winter Sing performance (on Friday, December 19, 2014).

All 3rd and 4th grade students will be informed of this audition opportunity during the week of November 10th in music class. Students who wish to audition must play for Mrs. LeMahieu or for Mrs. Prestipino prior to Friday, December 12th at 12:30 pm. Students may play during the first couple of minutes of their recess time, right after school, or (most likely) during the end of a music class period.

For the audition, students need not memorize their piece, although it should be well practiced. If the piece is not memorized, students will need to remember to bring their sheet music/book to school on the day they plan to audition. If a student is playing an instrument other than the piano, he or she will need to arrange to bring the instrument into school. Lastly, it is preferred that prelude pieces are holiday-themed, but this is not necessary.

Students will be informed on Monday, December 15th if they have been chosen to play in the Winter Sing prelude. All students who are well prepared will be asked to play for the performance. Again, pieces need not be memorized for the performance but they should be well practiced. The more comfortable students are with their pieces, the more enjoyable the performance!
